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Shawano County pay gap reaches fever pitch

Supervisor frustrated county can't fill vacant job positions, keep current staff

The lower pay affiliated with Shawano County employees in comparison with other counties or even the private sector has been an issue on the county's back burner for years now.

One county supervisor on the county's public safety committee made it clear April 7 that she not only wants the issue on the front burner, she also wants to turn up the heat. Supervisor Theresa Serrano brought up the issue at the committee meeting and intends to give her blistering critique at the next Shawano County Board meeting on April 20.

Serrano took exception to an email sent from Patrick Glynn of Carlson Dettmann Consulting, which has been working with the county on a salary structure, sent to the county's human resources manager, Rachel Tuma, regarding a job reclassification. In the email, Serrano said, Glynn did not think that an \$825 increase for a sheriff's department dispatch job position was warranted.

"I think it's ludicrous that they don't want to do anything to increase the dollar amount to our people who deserve it the most," Serrano said. "If people are doubling up on their position duties and more responsibilities are being given to them, I don't understand why this person is so hellbent on not increasing dollars for our people."

Serrano pointed out that surrounding counties are scooping up Shawano County's employees because they offer better pay and benefits, which leaves Shawano County constantly with vacancies. She said she doesn't see the point in working with the consulting firm if the response to providing more pay for more responsibilities is no.

"I'm saying it's crap," Serrano said.

Sheriff Adam Bieber had spoken earlier in the meeting about how the jail is in the process of hiring three new officers. Two of them were ready to roll except for one required evaluation, but the third person pulled out

because he was offered a job with more pay at a paper mill.

Bieber noted that his department is also interviewing to fill vacant deputy posts this month.

County Board Chairman Tom Kautza pointed out that the job description changes aren't the problem; it's the fact that the county has a finite amount of money to utilize. The county has approved the setup of a solar farm on the old County Farm property in the Town of Belle Plaine, which could bring in a lot of money to both the county and the town, but that potential pot of gold is likely years down the road.

"We have to have a larger pool of money to pay the employees," Kautza said. "It doesn't come from anywhere else. We've got to cut something to come up with more money to pay the employees."

Kautza said that he's recommended the county's committees look into what can be cut to provide more money to retain employees, but the cost-cutting suggestions have been very few.

"Nobody's volunteering up any programs that they think are a waste of money or not much benefit," Kautza said.

Serrano offered to take up researching the issue herself and potentially coming up with recommendations, as she feels the issue needs to be addressed now instead of continuing to kick the can down the road.

"If we keep going down this road with being OK with what they're getting, we're not going to have any cops around here," Serrano said. "I am mad. I'm very upset. I will make it my mission to continue with this."

Supervisor Richard Ferfecki said that the issue of paying county employees a wage that would make it difficult for other counties to poach them

has been an ongoing issue ever since he became part of the public safety committee.

"We're going to have to find the money somewhere," Ferfecki said.

Kautza told Ferfecki that he previously brought a recommendation to a committee to cut a full-time position down to part-time to free up a little money, but the committee outvoted him and decided to keep the position as it was. He said attitudes like that are what has kept the county where it is in terms of pay structure.

"The committees have got to step up and say we can't do things like this anymore," Kautza said.

Supervisor Jerry Erdmann countered that the county has been cutting positions and programs to the point where there's nothing else to cut.

"We know that departments still have to do their jobs," Erdmann said.

Kautza suggested Serrano's energy might be better focused by bringing the issue before a larger audience — the full county board — after she originally suggested going before the executive committee, where a lot of the administrative and financial recommendations are made.

"Under the county board comments, let them have it," Kautza said. "That's who has got to do it, the whole board."

Serrano said she would definitely take her case to the board, pointing out that there are a lot of older people on it who don't realize that the cost of living continues to go up, and leaving employees at a stagnant level of pay invites them to look elsewhere to pay their bills.

"I'm very passionate about this," Serrano said. "We are losing so many good people to other counties, and we've got to stop this. I'm not going to keep sitting in on interviews and get a deputy or correctional person, and you offer them the job and they say, 'No, I'm going to go work for the paper mill.'"

Shawano Police Department promotes 4 officers

Officers Ruen, Atkinson, Bamba and Burkel will be promoted to the rank of sergeant

Four police officers with the Shawano Police Department are being promoted to the rank of sergeant.

The four officers are Scott Ruen, Ryan Atkinson, Michelle Kamba and Brian Burkel. They have 50 years of police experience among them.

"Some of the things that were looked at, it really came down to experience," said Shawano Police Chief Bradley Rabideau. "For example, Atkinson and Ruen have been doing this job as officers in charge (OICs) for several years now, so that ability alone is not a huge step for them to move into the new role. With Kamba and Burkel, while their tenure here has not been that long, they still have a considerable amount of experience, both here and where they were before, with Kamba previously serving in Manawa and Burkel previously serving in Baraboo."

The position of sergeant is seen as a communication role between the patrol officers and administration. The position is being readded to the Shawano Police Department after 18 years. At that time, the people who were serving as sergeants became lieutenants.

The chief said those who are getting promoted will still have their duties as patrol officers. They will be given extra tasks, like making sure paperwork is done, all complaints are completed and all shifts are covered. The department is not hiring any new patrol officers, because those who are getting promoted will still serve those duties with that added work.

"It is everything that a patrol officer does plus a little bit more," Rabideau said. "That sergeant classification gives us the ability to add extra duties to their jobs."

The Shawano Police Department currently runs a "12-hour pitman" schedule, which breaks the department down into four shifts — two day shifts and two night shifts. The two patrol lieutenants, Mike Musolff and Heidi Cartwright, work that same pitman schedule.

"Those patrol lieutenants are not able to be here obviously 24 hours a day. So, what we have done from within the department, we have officers in charge, who were more or less in charge when lieutenants weren't

around, and what we have done is promoted them to a classification of sergeant," said Rabideau. "It gives them a little bit more authority to handle day-to-day operations within those shifts and more or less lead individuals."

The reorganization will provide more effective and efficient service to the community, Rabideau said. This will allow for better security and law enforcement coverage within the city, as well as produce better work from those employed with the police department.

"It is certainly going to have a major effect on reorganization, in that we will have more supervision 24 hours a day," said Rabideau. "The amount of supervision that we are going to have will increase considerably from what we have had before with just the two lieutenants."

Through reorganization, Rabideau mentioned that without utilizing any more money, the police department is able to take the same staff that they already have and serve and protect the community in a better way.

"We are able to utilize the resources that we have and change some of the job descriptions and titles in order

to better serve and get a better product from the people that are working here currently," said Rabideau.

According to Shawano City Administrator Eddie Sheppard, there will no additional budget impact from what was already approved in the 2021 budget. The new sergeants can expect to see about another \$2,000 a year each.

"The total net increase moving from the OIC model to the sergeant model totaled \$7,900," said Sheppard. "That was included in our 2021 budget, so there is no additional budget impact beyond what was already approved in the 2021 budget."

Rabideau elaborated on the logistics of the money that the sergeants will be receiving.

"In relation to the current bargaining agreement with the union association, OICs get a premium hourly rate; it's only like a dollar an hour (more)," said Rabideau. "With the elimination of the OIC position, those funds will help pay the sergeants."

Rabideau forecasts that the public will not be affected in a considerable way. The promotions will allow for higher surveillance in the community, though.

"I don't know that the public is

going to see a huge increase," said Rabideau. "Having that supervision out on the streets every day will afford the patrol officers more latitude in enforcing and serving the people in the community."

The Shawano community is very supportive of the department, Rabideau said, and he believes that the community will also support these promotions.

"We are attempting to provide a better service and be able to serve and protect those in our community in a better way," he said. "We would not have done this if there was not some type of positive gain for both the community and the department."

A formal swearing-in ceremony will take place at 6 p.m. Wednesday, April 14, in the Shawano City Hall community room during the common council meeting. The four new sergeants will assume their duties at the end of April.

"Our overall goal is to better serve and protect the citizens of Shawano," said Rabideau. "Not just the citizens, but those that work here, live here and travel here."

Gresham utility files for 31.6% rate increase

Water bills expected to increase average resident costs by \$12.19

After some urging by state regulators, the Gresham Municipal Water and Sewer Utility filed a 31.6% water rate increase, which received a public hearing April 7.

The Public Service Commission is expected to issue a rate order within weeks that could increase average residential monthly water bills by \$12.19, according to the PSC staff analysis.

Gresham's water utility had reported in 2018 that it had zero days cash on hand and incurred losses of \$43,677 during the past two years.

The PSC wants utilities to have available cash to cover 90 days' worth of expenses and have its revenue exceed expenditures.

"Commission staff is concerned that the ongoing financial integrity of Gresham Municipal Water and

Sewer Utility may be in jeopardy," according to an Oct. 18, 2018, letter to Lyle Grosskopf, then-village president.

The commission urged the utility to take immediate action to improve the utility's situation including a response within 45 days and filing a simplified rate increase which would have boosted revenue by 3%.

The utility did neither, wrote Jerel Ballard, PSC spokesman, in an email to the NEW Media.

Instead, the utility filed a 3% rate increase in 2019, and in May 2020, filed its first comprehensive rate case since 2014. The utility's accountants sought a 25.3% rate hike, which would have eliminated a projected \$6,324 income deficit, yielded an annual net income of \$38,311 and earned the utility a 3.5% rate of return of the value of its infrastructure investment.

PSC staff reviewed the request, recalculated some of the numbers and last month recommended the utility needed to earn a 6.3% rate of return to ensure long term financial viability. The larger return would

eliminate an operating deficit that PSC staff projected at \$1,549 and yield an annual net income of \$59,469.

The rate that PSC staff recommended would increase water bills of average residential customers using 2,000 gallons of water a month from \$38.56 to \$50.75, a \$12.19 increase or, 31.6%. The amounts include the fire protection charge, which covers hydrant maintenance and other costs to the utility associated with firefighting.

Rates for commercial, multi-family, public entity and industrial customers would also rise ranging from 25 to 45% depending on customer category and usage, according to PSC staff analysis.

No residents objected to the proposed rate hike at the April 7 hearing, said Brian Carroll, operations managers for Gresham Municipal Utilities. He added that the water utility's finances aren't as dire as the PSC figures indicated.

"We're covering all our debt and have never been late on loans. We have cash on hand but in different barrels," he said April 8.

Without going into detail, Carroll said there were "certain things a predecessor was not aware of, accounting companies were not aware of and the PSC wasn't aware of."

The village operates its own water, sewer and electric utilities and has transferred money between them as needed.

In order to satisfy the PSC audits, "the money must be put in the right pots, which it is," said Carroll.

The village board may have held down the requested rate of return to 3.5%, Carroll said, because "nobody wants to pay higher rates." However, the PSC recognizes that the utility needs enough revenue to continue to provide safe drinking water at a reasonable price.

Carroll likened delaying water rate increases to "kicking the can down the road, but it must stop some place."

With the higher rates, Carroll believes the water utility should have sufficient revenue to meet its obligation without borrowing from other village utilities.

"That's the whole goal," he said.

Summer school planning underway

Shawano public schools offering two sessions for students with in-person, virtual options

The Shawano School District's summer school program will be a lot easier for families this year as officials plan to keep the pandemic in the rear-view mirror and have a program similar to what was available in 2019.

There will be virtual options for families who are not ready for their children to be back inside the buildings, according to Rod Watson, summer school coordinator, but the district is planning in-person learning from Monday through Thursday for five weeks in June and July, as well as Friday field trips to Shawano Lake.

"If you remember, we had that planned last year, but the pandemic ruined everything, and we went virtual for the traditional session and an in-person outdoor session at the end of July and early August that was pretty well attended but didn't involve that many students," Watson said.

For most students, there will be four classes a day, many of them enrichment-based, according to Watson. Some new classes include Spanish for first and second grades, a literature lovers class, engineering classes and even coding classes.

"There are roughly 100 different classes that students can choose from," Watson said. "They are shuffled every year as teachers come and go for a specialty, so we might not be able to teach that anymore, but we offer other ones that teachers want to teach."

Some remediation takes place for students who need it, usually in reading, writing and math, Watson said.

The district is also planning a shorter, second summer session for the first three weeks in August, according to Watson. Students would take two classes per day in this session, he said, and some of the classes would help students to transition to a new grade or a new school, such as the freshman academy for students preparing to start high school.

"There's a class called Camp Third Grade, which I'm working on with teachers at Hillcrest (Primary School) and teachers at Olga Brenner (Intermediate School) about what skills they'd like all third-graders to have," Watson said. "There's also a Camp Sixth Grade for when they come over here (to Shawano Community Middle School)."

Other classes in that August session will also address social and emotional learning, according to Watson. That includes classes on structured play outside.

There has not been an interest in the virtual sessions as of April 6, when Watson presented the summer school plans to the Shawano School Board, but he anticipated some families will want to keep the learning going during the summer months but don't want to have their children in the building while the pandemic is still ongoing.

"There's all kinds of ways we can do it," Watson said. "We've just got to see what kind of interest there is."

Almost 120 students have already

signed up for summer school, with some of the students not from within the Shawano School District boundaries, and Watson is estimating there could be 1,000 students involved with classes by the time all is said and done.

"I've been doing this for seven years, and we usually have 500 or 600 who sign up traditionally, and the rest sign up later," Watson said. "It's sometimes hard for people to plan ahead."

Staffing could be a challenge, with interest from existing staff being lower, which Watson attributed to the topsy-turvy school year caused by the coronavirus pandemic. He noted that his current vacancies are in specialty classes, not the traditional ones.

"So far, student numbers are down, but it's hard to predict since we only opened things up a week ago," he said. "It's hard to determine how many students will want to do summer school."

Mother of suspect indicted in reservation shooting

A Keshena man and his mother were indicted this week in federal court in connection with a March 13 shooting on the Menominee Indian Reservation.

According to the three-count indictment, Menom L. Powless-Brown, 19, and Mary K. Powless, 42, both of Keshena, assaulted a man with a dangerous weapon with the intent to

harm by pointing a 9 millimeter semi-automatic handgun at another man, a Native American.

Count two of the indictment alleged that Powless-Brown discharged the firearm in relation to committing a violent offense, and count three alleged that Powless-Brown fired on another man with the intent to commit murder.

A news release from the U.S. Attorney's office described the indictment stating that, on March 13, Powless-Brown assaulted another man by

pointing a 9mm semiautomatic handgun at him, which he then discharged several times. Two individuals were struck with bullets, and at least one of them sustained significant injuries as the result of the shooting.

Mary Powless was charged with aiding and abetting assault with a dangerous weapon, in violation of, and if convicted faces a maximum of 10 years in prison.

Powless-Brown was charged with assault with intent to murder, punish-

able by 20 years in prison; assault with a dangerous weapon, punishable by 10 years in prison; and discharging a firearm during a crime of violence, punishable by life in prison.

No court dates have been set in the case.

The Menominee Tribal Police Department and Federal Bureau of Investigation investigated the alleged incident, which Assistant United States Attorney Andrew J. Maier will prosecute.

Shawano Area Fire Department responds to RV fire

Fire destroyed a recreational vehicle in Shawano on Thursday, April 8.

"We were paged about an RV smoking at 818 Randall St. around 10 a.m.," said Shawano Fire Chief

Shawn Borlace. "We were able to quickly knock out the fire, though."

The flames also engulfed a storage truck that was located in the field behind the RV. Borlace explained that both the RV and the truck were unsalvageable and determined to be total losses.

Borlace said that nobody was hurt

and the only things that were damaged by the fire were the vehicles.

According to Borlace, the cause of the fire is undetermined, but the poly fuel within the RV could have caused it to spread quickly.

"With that poly fuel, it doesn't take much to get the fire going," said Borlace.

Eighteen firefighters and 4,000 to 5,000 gallons of water were used to put out the fire. Borlace noted that 18 was a good turnout for a volunteer crew in the morning. On a typical night, as many as 30 firefighters might be able to respond.

Borlace estimated there to be around \$30,000 worth of damage.

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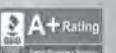

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Sturgeon return to Shawano to spawn

About 1,200
sturgeon handled
by Wisconsin DNR

Visitors swarmed the shores of Sturgeon Park on April 9 to watch the annual sturgeon migration.

Due to warmer weather and increased water temperatures, the sturgeon spawned early in 2021. With temperatures as high as 80 degrees during the past week, the water became warm enough for the fish to spawn.

“Due to the water temperature, this was the earliest in the five years that I have been here that I have seen them,” said Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources Conservation Warden Clark Delzer.

Spawning temperatures for sturgeon are around 52-60 degrees, according to Aaron O’Connell, a DNR sturgeon habitat biologist.

“Typically for the Winnebago system, these temperatures are met in mid- to late April,” O’Connell said. “But with the warm temperatures this spring, it occurred earlier.”

O’Connell mentioned that thousands of fish make a spawning run on the Winnebago system in any given year. On average, male sturgeon spawn every one to three years, while females spawn every three to five years.

As the weekend went on, more sturgeon filled the shores of the Wolf River at Sturgeon Park. With the growing amount of sturgeon at Sturgeon Park, more visitors followed. The sturgeon are easy to see because they swim shallow, with their mouths and fins poking out of the water on occasion. Like every year, the sturgeon are a popular site for visitors to come from all over the state to watch.

Rothschild resident Lynn Meyer was able to experience the marvelous event for the first time April 9.

“My experience has been interesting,” said Meyer. “I am just amazed that there are so many fish here.”

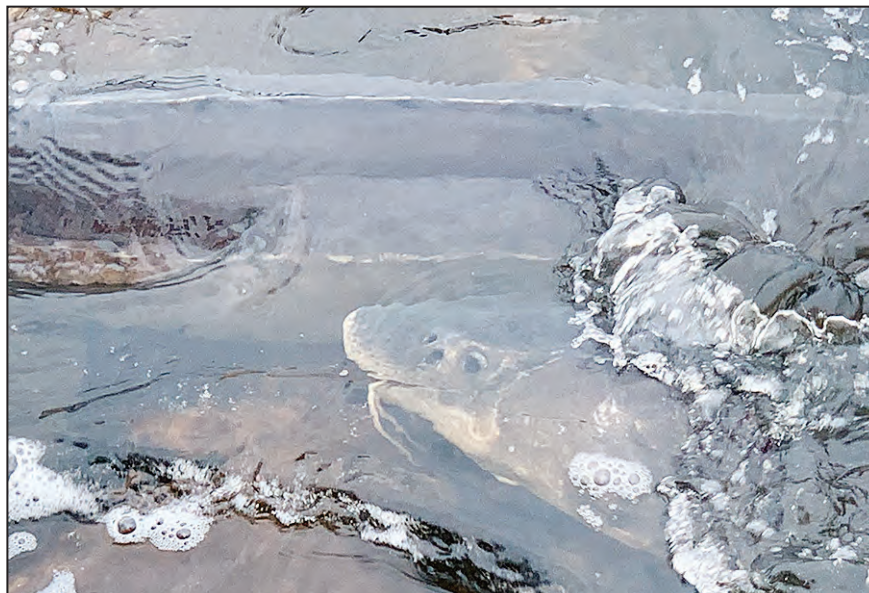
According to Delzer, Sturgeon Park is a hot spot for the migration and spawn of sturgeon due to how rocky the area is.

“The sturgeon need rocks to spawn,” said Delzer. “The eggs affix to the rocks, and the fish develop on those rocks.”

“I live right in town, so I come down here annually to see the sturgeon,” said Dave Berkahn, who has lived in Shawano for 40 years. “It is a really cool experience to see just how big the fish are.”

According to Delzer, these prehistoric fish can grow to be 200 pounds. When the sturgeon are born, they are about 1 inch long. That number jumps up to 3½ inches after about 45 days.

Shawano resident McKaslyn Szymanski makes a point to plan an annual trip with her children to see the sturgeon.

“We like to come every year and experience it,” said Szymanski. “It is very exciting for the kids to see the fish so close to the shore.”

A crew from the Wisconsin DNR was at Sturgeon Park over the weekend to tag and measure the sturgeon. The sturgeon are tagged in order to mark the new fish. They are also tagged for an easier estimate of the population of sturgeon. O’Connell said that the Wisconsin DNR has handled close to 1,200 sturgeon during this spawning run.

Having the ability to see these sturgeon make their spawning run is a unique experience for which many people around Wisconsin and further flock to Sturgeon Park.

“The Winnebago system sturgeon spawning run is unique in that this is one of the only places in the world to see the large number and large-sized fish spawning feet away,” said O’Connell. “The public areas on the Winnebago system that provide viewing of sturgeon spawning are incredibly unique and are unlike other systems.”

THE FABRICATION OF \$100,000

Stockbridge-Munsee officials see what Gresham school is doing with gift in fab lab

Members of the Stockbridge-Munsee Tribal Council got to see April 5 how their \$100,000 gift to Gresham Community School paid off.

School administrators took the council members on a tour of the new portion of the school, paid for through a \$6.5 million referendum approved by voters in 2019. Tim Bosman directs the school's new fabrication lab, which is where the tribe's gift went toward, and the former Antigo School District teacher said he's eager to be part of something so new.

"I think it's pretty awesome for the kids and the community," Bosman said. "It's a great start to something that's really going to be neat over the next couple of years. It's just more tools for them to apply their artistic ability."

Bosman showed the council members a number of items being created with 3-D printers, CNC technology, laser engravers and more. Besides the usual cutting boards and wooden hearts, projects have included engraved wooden bookmarks, metal welcome signs, keychains, cookie cutters and other items that are only limited by the imaginations of students and staff.

The fab lab requires students to put their math skills to work as they're designing something, according to Bosman.

"It's just a great way for students to apply those core concepts, and we know that, with regards to the future, a lot of it is in the trades, hands-on," he said.

Students will be able to use the 3-D printers to make items in hours whereas the time would be measured in days or even weeks, according to Bosman.

"Generac used to send their stuff out to get prototyped," Bosman said, noting his wife works for the company, "and it takes two weeks to a month to get it back to see if it's going to work."

The fab lab is also working to create items for elementary school students. Instead of making cards for Valentine's Day, kindergarten students received fabricated items to give to their parents. Bosman said items could also be made for gifts for Mother's Day or other holidays, but they can be

made for any occasion.

"The fourth grade was learning about the Iditarod, and they made ornaments, just something to remember it," Bosman said. "A lot of the fab lab isn't just for students learning to do these projects, but it's also to apply to the classrooms, because it helps with memory."

Bosman also showed that the lab can be used to create items with Native American symbols, as well. He displayed an item for the Stockbridge-Munsee officials that had the Mohican symbol for "Many Trails," a design that symbolizes endurance, strength and hope.

The CNC equipment will be utilized more next year, according to Bosman, and students will learn to fabricate cabinets and other larger items.

"It's going to be interesting to see how they come about it all," Bosman said.

There are also plans to open up the fab lab in the evening for adult education classes so community members can explore their creativity.

Bosman said the Antigo School District is utilizing Gresham's fab lab, noting he'd originally been slated to be that district's woodworking instructor,

and he's helping Antigo with some of its projects.

"Then they've helped us out with doing some machining," Bosman said.

Jolene Bowman, the tribe's vice president, was very pleased to see how the fab lab turned out. Gresham's student population includes some Stockbridge-Munsee tribal members, about 20 families or more by Bowman's estimation, so the lab will be good for those students as they try to ascertain what they want to do with their lives.

"It provides unique education for all grades to take advantage, and then they can be part of the school," Bowman said. "They'll feel invested in their own education, and there will be positive outcomes and destinations for them as a result. This is a fantastic opportunity for our community, for our families and for the students."

Education is a priority for the tribal council, according to Bowman. The tribe felt investing the \$100,000 would be paid back through future generations being able to obtain important skills to build and shape their futures.

"We want to be good stewards and neighbors to the communities that we live in with our families," Bowman said. "A community is not a commu-

nity without a school, and so we want to make sure we're here supporting the school."

Newell Haffner, the school's superintendent, said the fab lab could not have been completed without the gift from the Stockbridge-Munsee.

"The gift and the timing of that gift was huge," Haffner said. "We got some equipment that was better than what we could buy. We're happy driving a Buick, but now it's a Rolls-Royce."

With the help of the gift, the school was able to purchase an additional 3-D printer, according to Haffner, who is eager to see how well the students utilize it next year when there's a chance schools won't have to worry so much about the coronavirus pandemic. The school had planned to do some community activities with the fab lab, but the pandemic quashed those plans, he said.

"It's going to be cool to see the community come in and learning how to use some of the equipment," Haffner said. "We hope to have farmers come in and learning MIG and TIG welding. I'm excited to see what some of our community can design with the laser engraver."

WIC program clearing up misconceptions

Director wants to help families in need, show program not just a charity organization

The Women, Infants and Children Program has provided healthy food and nutrition education to those who need it for 50 years.

However, there are a number of those in need who still don't think it's a program that applies to them, according to Marianne Peshek, who manages Shawano County's WIC program. She's trying to dispel the rumors and point out that WIC is not just another charity organization.

"It is a federal program," Peshek said. "It's in every state in the nation."

WIC also provides breastfeeding services to mothers and helps refer people to other community service programs the county provides, according to Peshek.

"WIC works because we are significant in improving children's diets, and WIC leads to healthier babies," she said. "I'm a registered dietitian, so we do a lot of nutrition ed, but a lot of

it is the breastfeeding support and the referrals."

There is also a farmer's market program through WIC where families can get food directly from local farmers that's healthy and needed if there is some difficulty finding affordable food in the area, Peshek said. There are some local vendors who also accept WIC funding to provide healthy food.

Where Peshek is running into trouble is when she talks with families who are part of WIC and learns that others who are in need put up barriers, mostly from pride.

"They'll say assistance is for poor people, people that are not working or just using the system," Peshek said. "That is so not true. Most of our families are working families, and I can't say that enough."

WIC is a temporary assistance program, with families staying on until the children turn 5 years old, according to Peshek, although there could be some legislation in the works that

would extend the time until a child's sixth birthday.

"They're not living off the system or taking advantage," Peshek said. "Some of them are not making a livable wage, and they do need that food assistance."

The program also benefits mothers who are either expecting or postpartum, Peshek added. She has worked with churches and other organizations to get things like diapers donated to help those who just need a hand up.

Peshek is baffled at why people who are not able to get by think that they're lesser if they participate in a program like WIC. She has noticed some pushback from Hispanic families in need, noting that there are concerns the federal program could check on things like immigration status.

"A lot of people don't know that we do such a great job with nutrition education and helping people stay healthy," Peshek said.

She noted that WIC has started a new grant-funded program called

Fit Families. In the program, families set collective goals to get and stay healthy.

"It could be moving more," Peshek said. "It could be drinking more water, or it could be eating more fresh fruits and veggies."

The county's WIC program has seen a decrease in numbers in recent years, according to Peshek — even during the pandemic, when the number of people in need has skyrocketed.

"In big cities like Milwaukee, they have shot up," Peshek said about the same time period. "While we've previously seen a drop in the birth rate, in the last year we've seen an uptick."

There is not a waiting list to get onto the WIC rolls, she noted, and the funding comes from the U.S. Department of Agriculture.

For information or to enroll, call 715-526-2822. Currently, WIC assistance is not being handled in person due to the pandemic.

Lorge was born and raised in Clintonville, where she worked as a cook and bartender at Big Sal and Cheesy's Restaurant and Bar.

Lorge worked for the previous owners of Wildlife Bar and Grill as a bartender and waitress as well. After the previous owner was dealing with health problems, Lorge took over the bar and with her husband Thaddeus and they renamed it, Daisy's Place.

"I bar tended for the previous owner and due to health conditions, she needed someone to come in and bring some life back into the bar," said Lorge. "So we figured, why not?"

Daisy's place incorporates a full menu, including burgers, wings and fish. The bar and grill offers specials during the week, including taco Tuesdays, wing Wednesdays and fish fries on Friday.

"Our Friday fish fry is huge, as well as Taco Tuesdays," said Lorge.

Daisy's Place is often a destination place for residents in the Navarino community due to the fact that it is one of the only places in the town to get food.

"We are one of the only business in this town to get food," said Lorge. "So, we get a lot of different people in here — a lot of people at the bar and a lot of families as well."

Daisy's Place sits in a prime location, as snowmobilers and travelers often stop in for dinner or a drink. The bar and grill is welcoming to families as well, as they provide a dining area separate from the bar. Navarino also sits in an area in Wisconsin that is often frequented by those

who are traveling up north.

"We do get a lot of traffic from people who are traveling from Green Bay and Appleton," said Lorge. "Facebook has also been great as people are coming in from outside of the community after seeing pictures of the food."

With the COVID-19 pandemic continuing, Lorge and Blank have found it necessary to place hand sanitizer around the bar, as well as ask customers to keep an open bar stool between each other. They have also noticed that take-out has been popular among customers. Lorge and Blank are also accommodating in their efforts to serve those who don't feel comfortable coming into the building.

"If somebody does not want to come in and they want us to run food out to their car, we will accommodate them," said Blank.

With vaccines being more readily available, resulting in the pandemic slowing down, Lorge and Blank expect that more visitors and consumers will come in to eat and drink.

"We hear a lot of people say that they have got their second round of the COVID shot, so now they can come in and have a drink," said Lorge.

While working at Wildlife, Lorge noticed that the spring and summer months are the most busy.

"Spring and summer is our busy season," said Lorge. "With softball being played and us being on the main path when motorcyclists come through, it gets very busy in the spring and summer."

Even though this is the case, winter has been surprisingly busy as well.

"For the winter, there are hunting clubs and snowmobilers around," said Blank. "Those last couple days that

people were able to snowmobile were crazy for us."

The first two months of business for Lorge and Blank have been eventful as they have seen many people come in, as well as heard a positive public reaction about the bar.

"We have been welcomed into this town tremendously," said Lorge. "Everybody has been wonderful, they tell us how nice the place looks and how we are bring life back to the town."

Lorge and Blank are happy to run their own bar, as they do enjoy their time making their own schedule and working under their own guidance, as well as meeting people from all over the community.

"People of all ages are welcome to come in and dine and shoot pool," said Lorge. "It is just kind of like a hangout spot."
