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Bond set at \$750K for suspect in drug homicide

Victim died of fentanyl, methamphetamine and ethanol toxicity

Bond was set at \$750,000 on Feb. 1 for a Green Bay woman accused of first degree reckless homicide after drugs she had allegedly delivered caused a death.

Stephany L. French, 27, Green Bay, was charged with one count of first-degree reckless homicide by delivering drugs, one count of manufacturing or delivering less than three grams of heroin, one count of manufacturing or delivering less than or equal to three grams of amphetamine, one count of theft from a person or corpse and one misdemeanor count of duty to aid a victim or report a crime in connection with the Sept. 3 incident at the Mohican North Star Casino Resort in the Town of Bartelme.

According to the criminal complaint, police from the Stockbridge-Munsee Police Department were dispatched after security reported that a housekeeper found a deceased male while cleaning rooms.

The housekeeper stated that at 11:05 a.m. he knocked on room 508 and opened the door, because it was after checkout time. The housekeeper said that when he opened the door, he saw a man sitting on the floor. He closed the door, thinking it was a late check-out. At 12:35 p.m., the housekeeper witnessed a woman exiting the room, walking faster than what he perceived as normal. He added he saw the woman take the stairs, not the elevator.

The housekeeper said he went back to the room 30 minutes later and saw

the male sitting in the same position, with a lean to the right.

According to the complaint, the man was sitting cross-legged between the bed and the interior wall. There were two cellphone chargers plugged into the wall in front of him. The document also stated that there were three empty plastic cups on his lap and an empty hotel ice container and a head bandanna next to him. The man's clothes were wet and his head was leaning to the right. Shawano County sheriff's deputies found a white powdery residue on the nightstand next to the bed, but no drugs or drug paraphernalia were located in the room.

Hotel registration showed that Lynn French was listed as the man's guest. After searching his vehicle, authorities found paperwork for the owner of the car. After speaking with the owner, he stated that the victim was with his cousin, Stephany French, and alleged that she had a \$400 a day heroin habit. The victim's family stated that the victim liked to drink alcohol, but was not a drug user.

A detective stated in the complaint that the woman in the video was identified as Stephany French. The detective ran records on locating the victim's cellphone, which was not in the room. After finding the location of the phone, he did the same thing with French's cellphone records and found that it matched the victim's cellphone.

After French was arrested in De Pere, authorities received a search warrant for French's car. In the car, they found several cellphones, including the one that belonged to the victim.

Other things found in the car included a room key to room 508, three drug smoking pipes and a gem pack of drugs. One pipe and the gem pack tested positive for methamphetamine. Also found were naran kits. Almost 40 ATM receipts were also found in the car, showing that French spent approximately \$310 a day between July 22 and Sept. 20.

During French's first interview with the sheriff's department, she stated she did not know the victim, according to the complaint, and in her second interview, she stated that she had trouble remembering the night but said that there were no drugs involved.

According to the complaint, the autopsy report stated that the cause of death was listed as fentanyl, methamphetamine and ethanol toxicity. It said that the toxicity included pulmonary and cerebral edema.

French was once again interviewed, where she again denied involvement, according to the complaint. After the detective told French that there was video surveillance of her entering the room, she continued to deny her involvement. After showing her still photographs depicting her in the hotel, she stated that she didn't know what happened to the victim, according to the complaint.

After the detective explained that people overheat when using methamphetamine, he asked if the cups and ice tray were French's attempt of waking him up or cooling him down. French stated that she poured cold water on the victim to try to wake him up, according to the complaint.

Shawano man receives pardon from Evers

A Shawano man is one of 25 people who have received pardons from Gov. Tony Evers, the governor's office announced Feb. 7.

Michael L. Blume was 25 years old and employed at a department store when he took cash and made fraudulent refunds in 1994. He served one year on probation, has never committed another crime and now resides in

Shawano, where he is involved in the community and serves as the secretary for the Veterans of the Menominee Nation.

The Shawano-Menominee District Attorney's Office supported Blume's pardon application.

The Governor's Pardon Advisory Board heard from applicants virtually on Jan. 14, and applications that were selected for expedited review or recommended by the board were

forwarded to Evers for final consideration.

Evers has granted more pardons during his first three years in office — 416 — than any other governor in contemporary history.

"I'm proud to grant these 25 pardons today to recognize the hard work these folks have done in their communities and lives to make amends and give back to their communities," Evers said.

Firefighters respond to smoke at Martin's Cleaners

The Shawano Area Fire Department responded to a fire at Martin's Cleaners, 1025 E. Green Bay St., at 5:19 p.m. on Feb. 3.

Fire Chief Shawn Borlace said that the cause of the fire is undetermined.

"The origin of the fire would be in one of the dryers in the building," said Borlace. "Some people were drying some items and, for whatever reason, the fire did start inside the dryer."

Borlace said that there were no injuries during the fire. Other than a burnt dryer, Borlace said there was little to no damage.

"Most of the fire was contained to the dryer area," said Borlace. "The people drying the clothes actually tried putting it out using two fire extinguishers. The fire department pretty much finished it off."

He added the WE Energies was also called to the scene to handle a small gas leak inside the building, due to the fire.

According to Borlace, the fire

department found a little trouble with the smoke from the fire, but emergency workers were able to take control of the situation.

"There was quite a lot of smoke

inside the building," said Borlace. "That could have been really bad. Good thing that those people were able to contain the fire. That was a big deal to us."

Borlace said they responded with 26 firefighters, and they were on scene for a little more than an hour.

Future library planning moves forward

County officials hear pitches from firms on what they'd do to update library or build new facility

The Shawano County Public Property Committee and Shawano County Library Board are beginning the process to map out the future of the main branch of the Shawano County Library system.

Both panels interviewed three firms Feb. 3 to find out their processes and mindsets when it comes to designing a new library in Shawano. The county is looking at either renovating and expanding the existing facility on South Sawyer Street or finding a location in the city for a new library.

County officials listened to pitches from Engberg Anderson Inc., based in Milwaukee; Ayres Associates, based in Eau Claire; and Somerville Architects and Engineers, based in Green Bay. All three are vying to come up with plans to redesign the library to meet the area's needs over the next 25 years or more.

The current building across the way from Shawano City Hall on Sawyer Street, built in the 1960s, has some serious issues, according to county building maintenance director Steve Dreher, ranging from mechanics to space problems to environmental deficits. A study commissioned by the library board in 2019 determined that the library is going to need a facility double the size of the current building in Shawano to meet the community's needs for the next few decades.

Bill Robison, president of Engberg Anderson, noted that his firm has a history of designing and building libraries as he urged the two committees to hire his firm.

"Thirty-one years ago, the first thing I ever did was a library," Robison said. "Our firm has been doing libraries for its entire history, and we've worked on well over 200 library projects. They're kind of the thread that goes through the entire history of our firm."

Flexibility will be a necessary component, but Robison pointed out that building libraries is not cheap.

"At this point, I would rather you not overspend on the front design process so there are more resources to build the building you want to do," Robison said.

Mark Paschke, an architect with Ayres, told the committees that he hopes to hit the ground running

with a facilities assessment utilizing the firm's engineers to look at every space in the library. The report would include information on whether the existing facility could be expanded or if it would be more economical to renovate an existing building or build an entirely new facility.

Paschke noted that new construction could cost the county \$200 per square foot, while renovations could be as low as \$75 per square foot.

"Libraries are becoming resources for the community in terms of workforce training, that kind of community involvement," Paschke said, noting that one of the libraries that Ayres developed had an incubator facility for start-up businesses to get off the ground.

Jodi Nelson, another Ayres architect, said that her firm would hold community meetings to get information from the public to see what they want in a revamped library. She also advocated posting plans on a website for public feedback, although she noted that method lacked the personal touch.

"We would provide floor plans and

site plans, diagrams and other information to get feedback," Nelson said.

Melanie Parma, senior vice president for Somerville, noted that Somerville has been part of northeast Wisconsin for 75 years and that her firm would spend a lot of time getting public participation in the planning process.

"We'll continue to communicate with the community so that they understand what's happening at each phase of the process," Parma said.

Dan Wiitanen, a senior architect with Somerville, noted that libraries are evolving, so the facility that is determined for Shawano will need to be adjustable to conform to the community's needs in the coming decades.

"Libraries are evolving from a place where I can get things to a place where I can do things," Wiitanen said. "You want to attract more users to the Shawano County Library, but still keeping those loyal visitors that come in."

In terms of the cost for the proposals, Engberg Anderson and Ayres bid around \$47,000 to \$48,000, while Somerville's bid came in just over

\$12,000, prompting Dreher to ask Parma and her colleagues whether the county would get the same level of research and recommendations that it would get from the other firms.

"We are very relationally driven," Parma said in response to Dreher's inquiry. "We've worked with the county before — you are our neighbors. Our goal would be to build a relationship with you and hope you would be thrilled with our work and want to continue working with us."

Supervisor Deb Noffke, who sits on the public property committee, pointed out that any building is going to need to be one that the taxpayers of the county can afford.

"This isn't an affluent county, which means the library is so important," Noffke said. "Yet, we don't want a huge project that goes down in flames, and then nothing gets done."

The public property committee and library board are planning to meet again after digesting the information and vote on which firm they want to hire at the end of this week.

School board green-lights fundraising

Scoreboard, weight room items, theater sound equipment expected to cost district over \$500K

The Shawano School District is going to be looking for benevolent donors with big pockets to help finance some big-ticket items for its sports and fine arts programs at Shawano Community High School after the Shawano School Board gave the green light Feb. 7.

The board gave permission for administrators to fundraise for a new scoreboard for the school's football field, new equipment for its weight room and new sound shells and sound equipment for its auditorium. According to Superintendent Randi Anderson, those four items would cost more than \$500,000, and they are not currently in the budget.

"These items have been crucial, and they've been identified for the last couple of years," Anderson said. "We'd like to be able to go out and start to fundraise for them. We really want to start moving this forward as we start driving towards that destination district."

Anderson did not give the board specifics on how the district would raise the money, but it could include offering naming rights to bigger donors, if the price is right. In order for that to happen, though, the board would need to develop a policy outlining how and when naming rights could be offered.

"We do not have the funds inside of our district budget to support these items," Anderson said. "They have been a huge priority for the district for the last several years, so we wanted to move them forward."

Anderson told the board that there is a person in the district to "champion" raising the funds.

Board member Jamie Beyer was among those who wanted to know how the district planned to raise such a large amount of money.

"Are you approaching large companies to have naming rights, or is it bake sales and car washes?" Beyer said.

Anderson replied that it could be a "combination" of things but did not specify, although she said there would be more discussion on the "strategy moving forward."

"If we go to naming rights, if that is the direction we go to, then we'll come back with parameters on what that could look like, based off of board policy," Anderson said. "We have to get approval first, and then we'll look at the specifics."

Board president Michael Sleeper noted that the issue of naming rights has come up previously, and he and board member Diane Hoffman noted that there is no policy in place for giving someone naming rights in exchange for a large donation.

"We have denied things in the past because we did not have a

policy," Hoffman said. "It has been a discussion for the last seven years, at least — possibly 12. It is something we need to look at. I'm fine with fundraising, but we shouldn't go down an avenue if we don't have something set up."

Sleeper noted that it would be something that the district's policy committee would be looking at in the future.

Board member Mart Grams, prior to voting, said he wanted to make sure these items were only going to be fundraising items and wouldn't be things that taxpayers would have to foot the bill for. He said he has seen other schools succeed with fundraising and wants to see Shawano do the same.

"I don't want this to become a commercial center, like when you watch soccer all over the world and there's 5,000 ads. All you see is the ads and not the team," Grams said. "Also, I would not like it to be, 'Oh, fundraising failed. Now we're going to make the taxpayers pay.' I have a problem with that, like it's a sneaky way of getting stuff in. If you fundraise it, then I agree with it 100%."

Anderson noted that the four items are vital if the school district is going to be one in which families want to enlist their children.

The four items are also part of a longer conversation the district is having about expanding and reno-

vating athletic and fine arts facilities as a whole. The conversation started in February 2020, before the pandemic derailed things. The board was at that time looking at a plan that could cost about \$3.3 million, with the potential of tapping into the district's fund balance, which was then sitting at \$7 million.

The pandemic forced Wisconsin schools to close less than a month later, and the topic took a back seat to how to keep education going in a pandemic and how to keep schools open. However, in January of this year, discussions on performing arts and athletics facility improvements came up again. It was during a town hall meeting the district had with the community where it was announced that the district is looking at an estimated \$26 million in maintenance projects at all the schools over the next 10 years, a time when enrollment is expected to continue to drop.

After that meeting, the district developed an ad-hoc committee of what it calls its stakeholders to look at the facilities and figure out ways to pay for the maintenance projects. The committee met Jan. 31 and is expected to meet again in February. The committee is expected to bring some recommendations to the board sometime in the spring.

Shawano County moving forward with redistricting map

The Shawano County Redistricting Committee is moving forward with its proposed redistricting map.

The decision was made during the committee's Feb. 2 public forum and subsequent meeting. With no one from the public giving input, the committee decided to approve the map that was discussed at its Sept. 30 meeting.

During that Sept. 30 meeting, the

only change made to the map was in the Town of Angelica, at the suggestion of Angelica supervisors James and Connie Przybylski.

"We would like some consideration on the maps that we sorted through," said James Przybylski. "The total population works out pretty fine. We have quite a few wards and we would like to keep it at a minimum of at least three."

Connie Przybylski said that the Town of Angelica has talked to Shawano County GIS coordinator David

Poffinbarger about the proposed redistricting map.

"Right now, we have four ballots that we deal with," she said. "If we condensed to this, we would only have three ballots."

James Przybylski added that a lot of questions come up around election time, with residents asking, "Why should I vote for this person if they are not in my district?"

During this meeting, Poffinbarger said that in the Przybylskis' proposal, the population is almost identical.

There would be a -1.55 deviation to a -1.56 deviation.

A deviation is how far away a district is compared to the ideal population. The ideal population is taking the total number of people in the county and dividing it by the number of districts. The final map must have every district within 5% of the ideal population.

The Shawano County Redistricting Committee voted to forward the proposed redistricting map to the Feb. 26 County Board meeting.

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Elected officials getting pay increase

Clerk of courts, sheriff, coroner to get 4% hike first year, then 3% in subsequent years

Pay raises are coming for elected officials in Shawano County.

The public safety committee voted Feb. 2 to give a 4% increase in pay to the county coroner, clerk of court and sheriff. The 4% pay increase would go into effect for the first year, while a 3% pay increase would be for every subsequent year. One other change was made that involved the county coroner, Brian Westfahl, as well.

"The biggest change here would be that Brian Westfahl would move to a full-time salary position and not be paid by call," said Administrative Coordinator Jim Davel. "The biggest change is not necessarily the salary, but Brian would be on benefits."

Being on benefits and having a full-time salary would mean that the coroner would get paid to go to meetings and putting together the budget, among other tasks.

Supervisor Theresa Serrano asked why this was not in place in the past.

"I think this has been an evolution as the position has grown," said Davel. "Back in the day, you didn't need a full-time coroner. We are trying to make this not only beneficial to the county, but we have to get people to at least think about running for that office."

The resolution called for a 1.5% pay increase to begin the meeting.

"That's what the last employees got on the budget," said Davel. "If you want to change that, I have no issues with that. If you are going to change it, I would go no lower than 2%. Last time in the budget, we could afford 3%."

Serrano responded with her thoughts on how much of a pay increase there should be.

"I would say 3% across the board for all of these today (clerk of courts, coroner and sheriff)," said Serrano.

Supervisor Tom Kautza said that if they are giving 3% pay increases to county employees, that money could add up quickly.

"If you don't pay the people, they aren't going to do the job," said Serrano. "Then what are you going to do?"

She suggested that to pay the 3% increase, the county should add 3% to the general fund and to get the solar farm working.

"We can't guarantee that we can get this stuff working," said Kautza.

Supervisor Jerry Erdmann reiterated Serrano's point, saying the county has to make an investment in the staff.

Shawano County Chief Deputy George Lenzner said that they cannot keep going down as a county.

"We can tell you that it is harder and harder to find employees," said Lenzner. "There are other counties that are giving bonuses."

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Rec marijuana cash cow for Illinois, Michigan

While Wisconsin Legislature considers medical marijuana, neighboring states reap rewards

Illinois has collected more than \$400 million in tax revenue from recreational marijuana sales in 2021, and Michigan has collected nearly \$250 million, according to the two states.

Wisconsin still bans the drug in most forms, but the legislature continues to flirt with legalizing medical marijuana.

Minnesota and Iowa have already legalized the drug for medical purposes, though not recreationally.

In the two years since launching its recreational marijuana program, Illinois has received more than half a billion dollars in tax revenue, according to the Illinois Department of Revenue.

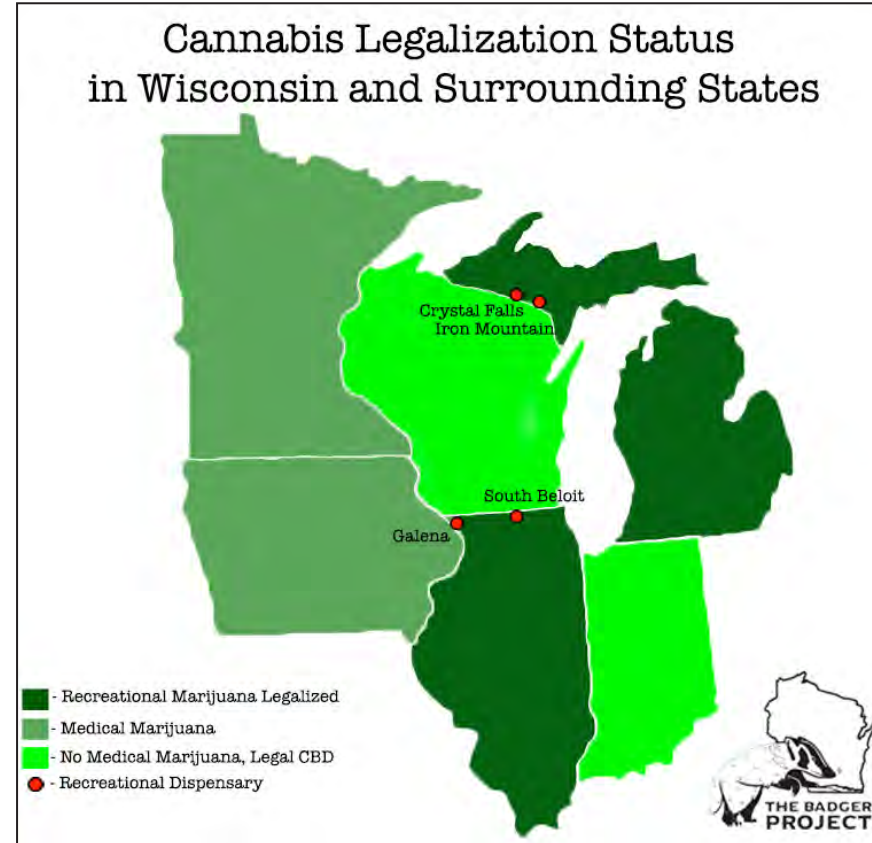
Over \$100 million of that will finance programs aimed at investing in communities hardest hit by the drug war, with a large chunk going to fund grants for minority communities disproportionately impacted by gun injuries, child poverty, unemployment and incarceration, the state says. About \$100 million was deposited into Illinois' general fund.

Funds from cannabis revenue will also go to local governments, a marijuana regulation fund, facilitating the process of expunging criminal marijuana charges, administrative costs, a public health campaign and research on the effects of legalization.

Recreational marijuana tax revenue is described as a "found money" resource, where one previously didn't exist, by Douglas Berman, a law professor at Ohio State University and the director of the Drug Enforcement and Policy Center there.

"If the money is used well, it can do a lot of good," Berman said. "It's not going to fill every pothole or solve every pension crisis, however it can be wonderful for additional resources."

Of the more than \$200 million gathered in Michigan, \$20 million will be given annually to clinical trials researching the efficacy of marijuana in treating veterans' medical conditions and preventing veteran suicide, according to state documents. Funds will also go to a K-12 school aid fund, repair and maintenance of roads and bridges, and municipalities and counties where



marijuana businesses are located.

Under Wisconsin law, marijuana possession is a felony, though the state has legalized products from non-intoxicating cannabidiol, commonly known as CBD, and the growing of hemp.

Marijuana is classified as a Schedule 1 drug both federally and in Wisconsin, meaning the governments officially consider it to have a high potential for abuse, no currently accepted medical use in treatment in the United States and lacking accepted safety for use in treatment under medical supervision.

Other Schedule 1 drugs at the state level include heroin, MDMA and PCP.

"There's this widespread sense that the harms expressed at the outset (of legalizing recreational marijuana) may exist a little bit, but they haven't been as big a deal as you might think," Berman said.

Marijuana legalization has little effect on the crime rate in either direction, according to an ongoing study by the Cato Institute, a libertarian think tank based in Washington D.C., though it notes the data is still limited. A study from the National Bureau of Economic Research found little to no change

in traffic crashes in places where cannabis had been legalized.

Wisconsin state Sen. Melissa Agard, D-Madison, has introduced a bill to legalize recreational marijuana in each of the last five legislative sessions, and it has failed each time. When she first proposed the bill in 2014, it received only five co-sponsors, she said. Her 2021 effort lists 40 co-authors and co-sponsors of the bill, all Democrats. Republicans, who have controlled the legislature since 2011, have ignored the bill in committee, where it must pass before going to a full vote in the state Senate.

The state Senate recently took up a bill that increases penalties for a person who uses a butane torch to extract resin from a cannabis plant. Agard introduced an amendment to the bill that would have legalized marijuana in any form. Republicans killed Agard's amendment and passed the initial bill on a 21-12 party-line vote.

"The fact that Wisconsin is an island of prohibition in the Midwest continues to harm folks in our state," Agard said. "At a time when economic recovery is at the tip of everyone's mind, it's really shortsighted that we are not moving

policy forward to welcome a billion-dollar industry that's knocking on the door."

Gov. Tony Evers included a provision in his last budget proposal that would have legalized recreational marijuana, but Republicans cut the proposal before passing the budget.

Senate Majority Leader Devin LeMahieu (R-Oostburg) has said the state should wait for the federal government to legalize medical marijuana before doing so.

Assembly Speaker Robin Vos (R-Rochester) has said he is open to medical marijuana, though he wants it legalized in a limited way that doesn't involve "a marijuana shop on every corner."

Last week, state Sen. Mary Felzkowski, R-Irma, and state Rep. Patrick Snyder, R-Schofield, introduced a bill that would create a new state commission to regulate medical marijuana. Physicians who earn certification from the commission would be allowed to prescribe marijuana.

Felzkowski told reporters at a news conference that LeMahieu is "more than willing" to allow a hearing after a similar bill proposed by her failed to gain any traction in 2021.

"We have a trend in this state to look for more natural types of healthcare," Felzkowski said in the news conference. "Empower those who look to natural immunity, natural healthcare, and beefing up our bodies holistically instead of just using a prescription type of medication."

Medical marijuana is very popular in Wisconsin. A 2019 Marquette University Law School poll found 83% of registered voters in Wisconsin backed the idea. A smaller majority, 59%, supported legalizing marijuana recreationally.

"There's always going to be a sort of rural/urban divide when it comes to marijuana because of the politics, but that divide isn't clear in the policy," Berman said. "Rural communities generally support the idea. You can grow and make profit in those rural communities — or they might be using weed too and people don't realize it."

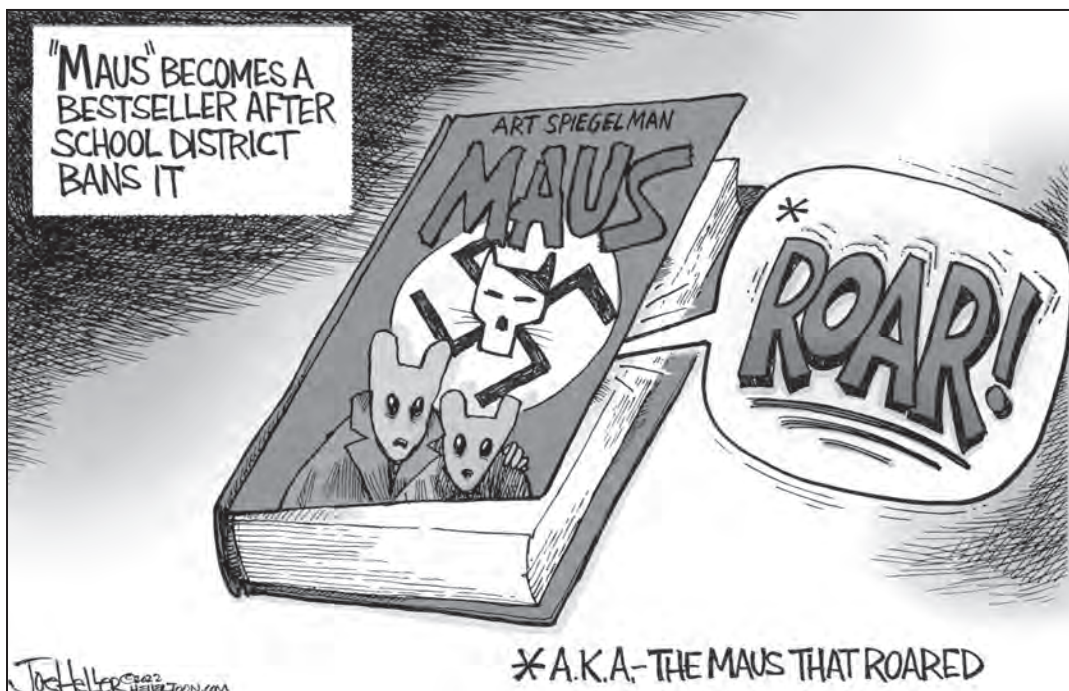

Love of horses inspires new barn quilt

Shawano County's 384th barn quilt, a unique stained-glass pattern called Just Horsing Around, is now on display on a barn owned by Jay and Trisha Selle at W6873 Robin Road, Wittenberg. The quilt was a Christmas gift to Jay and Trisha from their children, Jay and Amber Selle, Kevin Rash and Jess, and Dustin and Regan Rash.

Notice of Spring Primary Election and Sample Ballots School District of Pulaski

Office of the Pulaski School District Clerk
To the voters of Pulaski School District:

Notice is hereby given of a spring primary election to be held in Shawano County for the residents of the Pulaski School District, on February 15th, 2022, at which the officers named below shall be nominated. The names of the candidates for each office, whose nominations have been certified to or filed in this office, are given under the title of the office, each in its proper column, in the sample ballot below.

Information to Voters

Upon entering the polling place and before being permitted to vote, a voter shall:

- state their name and address
- show an acceptable form of photo identification*
- sign the poll book**

***If a voter does not have acceptable photo identification, the voter may obtain a free photo ID for voting from the Division of Motor Vehicles.**

****If the voter is unable to sign the poll book due to disability, a poll worker may write the word "exempt."**

If a voter is not registered to vote, they may register to vote at the polling place serving their residence if the voter provides proof of residence.

Where ballots are distributed to voters, the initials of two inspectors must appear on the ballot.

Upon being permitted to vote, the voter shall enter a voting booth or go to a machine and cast their ballot. The vote should not be cast in any manner other than specified here. Sample ballots or other materials to assist the voter in marking their ballot may be taken into the booth and copied. The sample ballot shall not be shown to anyone so as to reveal how the ballot is marked.

A voter who is a parent or guardian may be accompanied by the voter's minor child or minor ward.

An election official may inform the voter of the proper manner for casting a vote but the official may not advise or indicate a particular voting choice.

Assistance for Voting

A voter may select an individual to assist in casting their vote if the voter declares to the presiding official that they are unable to read, have difficulty reading, writing, or understanding English, or that due to disability are unable to cast their ballot. The selected individual rendering assistance may not be the voter's employer or an agent of that employer or an officer or agent of a labor organization which represents the voter.

Where Paper Ballots are Used

The voter shall make a mark (X) in the square next to the name of the candidate of their choice for each office for which they intend to vote. To vote for a person whose name does not appear on the ballot, the voter shall write in the name of the person of their choice in the space provided for a write-in vote.

Where Touch Screen Voting is Used

The voter shall touch the screen to select the name of the candidate of their choice for each office for which they intend to vote. To vote for a person whose name does not appear on the ballot, the voter shall type in the name of the person of their choice in the space provided for a write-in vote.

After Voting the Ballot

After an official paper ballot is marked, it shall be folded so the inside marks do not show, but so the printed endorsements and inspectors' initials on the outside do show. The voter shall deposit the voted ballot in the ballot box or deliver the ballot to an inspector for deposit and shall leave the polling place promptly.

After an official touch screen ballot is cast, the voter shall leave the polling place promptly.

Spoiling Ballots

If a voter spoils a paper ballot, they shall return it to an election official who shall issue another ballot in its place, but not more than three ballots shall be issued to any one voter. If the ballot has not been initialed by two inspectors or is defective in any other way, the voter shall return it to the election official who shall issue a proper ballot in its place.

The voter may spoil a touch screen ballot at the voting station before the ballot is cast.
