WAM FEST RETURNS TO WABENO AUG. 7

The most unique art and music festival in Forest County, WAM Fest (Wabeno Art and Music Fest) is back from 11 a.m. to 10 p.m. Aug. 7 in downtown Wabeno, on state Highway 32.

Celebrating its sixth year, WAM Fest is a jam-packed day of art and music fun for the whole family. The band shell and side stage will feature continuous entertainment including Irish and native dance, Gospel music and many other regional, talented musicians on stage all day, along with the headliner, the folk, rock alternative and country band Water Street Jacks, at 8 p.m.

The event features food, drinks, raffles, kids activities and art for sale.

"Artful Activities" are scheduled from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m. near the Wabeno Logging Museum including a scavenger hunt, sidewalk chalk art, creative bubble hoops, stone stacking, and coloring and doodles. All ages young and young at heart are welcome.

The museum is also hosting the first Historic Wabeno Art Challenge, with 45 pieces of art already on display through Aug. 7. Silent auction bids may be made and others purchased; the auction closes at 3 p.m. Aug. 7, and the high bidder need not be present to win.
