High school juniors, parents learn about post-high school plans

Juniors at Wittenberg-Birnamwood High School are getting ready to make that next step to senior year, and many will start to arrange their plans for college.

Wittenberg-Birnamwood High School guidance counselor Stephanie Gruber gave a presentation on what both students and parents can expect for the future as students finish their junior years.

"They have to be the builders of their future; I can't tell them what they are going to do after high school," said Gruber. "I can definitely help them get there, though."

An audience of 15, including both students and parents, were in attendance to gather the information needed to finish building their resumes and start applying for colleges.

In the presentation, Gruber explained that, with the COVID-19

pandemic, some schools are not requiring that students submit ACT scores.

"What I have been telling students is that, before you schedule to retake the ACT, let's talk about it and see if some of the schools that you are interested in are even requiring it," said Gruber.

Gruber also mentioned that in order to become summa cum laude in high school, students must achieve a score of 26 or better on the ACT.

With regard to financial aid, Gruber talked about the Free Application for Federal Student Aid, or FAFSA, and encouraged students to complete the form, even if they aren't likely to qualify for grants.

"There are scholarships out there that require the FAFSA to be filled out in order to apply," said Gruber. "If students don't want to do their FAFSA, they most likely want to do scholarships, so I would have that filled out."

Gruber also mentioned that,

through Northcentral Technical College, a financial aid meeting and workshop is in the works to be scheduled for mid-October.

"Families are strongly encouraged to come to that," said Gruber. "NTC usually comes here and presents on what loans are, the scholarships and grants that you can get and everything else financial aid-related."

Gruber added that the representatives from NTC will help families fill out the information regarding financial aid at the meeting.

Gruber, who has spent five years as the guidance counselor at WBHS, has worked with many students and parents. She said she's found it beneficial to hold a meeting to discuss the next steps in a student's post-high school career.

"The meeting has benefits for students because, instead of the students having to inform their parents and relay that information to them, it can be more of a conversation,"

said Gruber. "This way, the parents know what the students should be doing and they can figure that out together."

This is the second meeting that Gruber has hosted with an emphasis on post-high school plans for parents with students in 11th grade. Last year, the meeting was done virtually, where Gruber made a slide show and recorded herself talking over it.

"I like holding this meeting in

person more because I am able to present to them and they can ask questions as we go along," said Gruber. "There is a little bit more of a conversation, whereas with a Google Meet or Zoom meeting, trying to go back and forth can be a mess."

With the meeting, Gruber has also put the slideshow of her presentation on the school's website, <https://www.wittbirn.k12.wi.us>, for those parents and students who may

have missed it.

Gruber mentioned that, in a small school setting, she has more time to sit down with students and families to help them plan out their futures.

"I love the small school setting," said Gruber.

According to Gruber, public feedback from this meeting and meetings in the past has usually been pretty positive.

"Feedback is usually pretty good," said Gruber. "Usually it's

just parents saying that it was an informative meeting, and they give me suggestions on what I can cover on in the future."

Gruber went on to establish how important it is for students to have post-high school plans.

"I would say that it is very important for students to have plans for after high school," said Gruber. "I try to view high school as being used for four years to prepare for the future."

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Board hires Elexco to fix SCMS storm sewer issues

The Shawano School Board signed off April 19 on a project to fix flooding and water issues at Shawano Community Middle School that's expected to cost more than \$411,000.

The board decided to move forward with a full four-phase plan to have Elexco, a Seymour company, repair the school's storm sewer system, install sediment basins to address the blockage discovered

months ago, and hopefully stop the undermining of the school's foundation and production of mold. The board was initially scheduled to approve the project April 5; at that time, only the cost of the first three phases was available, and board members wanted to know the cost of the fourth and final phase.

Shawn Mathwich, Shawano School District buildings and grounds director, told the board that the \$411,490 price tag would be paid for through the district's ample

fund balance. Doing all four phases together is expected to save the district about \$6,000 in the long run, according to Mathwich.

"With the sediment basins, I think that's very good precautionary," Mathwich said. "There are no guarantees in life, but we're taking our best educated guess with the people who are at the forefront of this."

Mathwich added that there would be additional cost savings in not having to manage damage caused by the flooding, which includes im-

pacting boiler room equipment and more.

"I don't think this is something we want to experience anymore," Mathwich said.

Tyler Schmidt, outgoing school board president, said that the videos from Elexco's initial investigative work showed that the work could not be put off.

"We need to assess those and take care of those," Schmidt said.

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Masks 'encouraged but not required' in county facilities

The consensus of the Shawano County Executive Committee on April 14 was to take no action toward mandatory mask-wearing in county facilities.

Questions arose after the state Supreme Court ruled March 31 that Gov. Tony Evers did not have the au-

thority to extend an emergency mask requirement without consulting with the Legislature, County Board Chairman Tom Kautza said.

"When the governor lost in the Supreme Court, everyone was wondering what to do," Kautza said. "I said basically it's voluntary. If you want to wear them, you can; if you don't want to, you don't have to."

Supervisor Kathy Luebke said she

likes the wording on the new signs posted at the north and south entrances of the courthouse: "The use of masks or face coverings in this facility is encouraged but not required."

Supervisor Mark Bolin said the issue came up at the Human Service Committee meeting the previous day.

"Most of the public actually is masking up when they come in there; they're making that choice to do it

themselves," Bolin said.

Human services personnel are wearing masks when they call on clients in their homes.

There would probably be more controversy if the county were to try to enforce a mask requirement, said Supervisor Kevin Conratt.

"We don't want to be the mask police," said interim administrative coordinator James Davel.

Britt's Ice Cream and Candy Shop provides community with a place to convene on hot days

One ice cream shop in Wittenberg is expecting a business boom this summer.

Rick and Karla Verkuilen own and operate Britt's Ice Cream and Candy Shop in the heart of Wittenberg, at 502 S. Webb St. Britt's has served as a spot for people in the community to sit and talk with each other.

"You have some locals who come in, grab some food and just sit and talk," said Rick Verkuilen.

"I love that," added Karla Verkuilen.

The Verkuilens came up with the idea for the shop in April 2020. Karla Verkuilen mentioned that with the COVID-19 pandemic going on and all of the negative stories within the news, she wanted to open a shop that would bring joy to people. Britt's Ice Cream and Candy Shop ultimately opened Aug. 1.

"I had to do something positive," said Karla Verkuilen. "People just need some happiness in their lives. There is so much to make people afraid and sad."

Growing up in a small town, Karla Verkuilen also mentioned that owning and operating her own shop has always been a dream.

"I always wanted a grocery store," she said. "I grew up in Hatley, and every little town has their own little grocery store, and that was my first job. You go back to things that you remember early in your life."

Britt's Ice Cream and Candy Shop carries more than just sweets. Items like Chicago-style hot dogs, cheese curds and ham roll-ups grace the menu as well.

"We tried Chicago-style hot dogs and it was maybe two weeks that we got it going and it seemed like it was a huge hit," said Karla Verkuilen. "We are just trying to think of things to serve that people would like."

The Verkuilens noted that even through the pandemic, business has exceeded their expectations.

"I would say the first eight months are going fabulous," said Karla Verkuilen. "I don't think that we have anything to complain about."

"You get times where it is slow, but you also have times where there are not enough people working to help with all of the customers," said Rick Verkuilen.

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Britt's Ice Cream and Candy Shop will be open six days a week, Tuesday through Sunday from 11 a.m. to 7 p.m. starting at the beginning of May. There are currently three part-time employees.

"If it picks up in the summer, we will add another hour and stay open until 8 p.m.," said Rick Verkuilen.

As summer starts to pick up and more people come in for ice cream and food, Karla Verkuilen hopes to install more seating outside the store.

"We are thinking about adding an outdoor space and putting some bistro tables out there," said Karla Verkuilen.

"We will clean up the back alley and put up some bistro tables and lights for customers," added Rick Verkuilen.

Within the Wittenberg community, the Verkuilens often see many fa-

miliar faces. They have experienced some people coming in from farther outside of Wittenberg, though.

"We have had one lady come in from Australia," said Rick Verkuilen. "She was with a group, and they all came through Wittenberg to look at the murals."

The Verkuilens hope to get more advertising out in the community by putting new signs on the building as well as putting signs out by the highway.

The Verkuilens share some fond memories with the store, as it used to be a jewelry store. Rick Verkuilen and his sisters used to come in and buy jewelry, he said.

According to Rick Verkuilen, business is expected to rise come summer. This is due in part to the Verkuilens' interaction with the community.

"We decided to sponsor little league this year," said Rick Verkuilen. "We have plans scooping ice cream at events with Long Chiropractic Center, Country Fresh Meat and the school district."

The Verkuilens have mentioned that the public response to the shop has been positive.

"The community has been very supportive," said Karla Verkuilen.

"People come in before their shifts at their job to get some food, like cheese curds," added Rick Verkuilen.

According to the Verkuilens, the whole community has supported the business and wants to keep it running strong.

"I want this to be very family friendly," said Karla Verkuilen. "I am just hoping that we are a bright, sunny spot for Wittenberg."

Cameron graduates from drug court program

Rigors require lengthy commitment from participants

A Shawano man has made the next step on his path towards rehabilitation.

Bradley Cameron became the second graduate of the Shawano County Drug Court program on April 15.

"It is a big celebration because this is a difficult program," said Judge William F. Kussel Jr. "This is hard work — it is not an easy way to get out of an addiction."

According to Drug Court Treatment Coordinator, Becky Edgren, the drug court program was put into place to give individuals with substance abuse problems a chance to become sober, rebuild their lives, avoid long periods of incarceration, achieve job training and heal relationships with their families and friends.

The first member of the drug court program was accepted in 2018 and two years later in 2020, the drug court held their first graduation.

Cameron's acceptance into drug court was Sept. 23, 2019. Throughout the process, Cameron attended 37 different drug treatment hearings, worked over 2,000 employment hours and attended over 350 recovery support group meetings within the Shawano community.

"As of April 15, Brad has 661 days of personal sobriety time," said Edgren.

Cameron continues his path to rehabilitation as a recovery coach, helping those in the community deal with their time recovering.

According to Edgren, when the COVID-19 pandemic hit, most services and supports began to shut down. and the potential for relapse was even greater.

"Brad reacted as the leader and helped to set up and restart the daily recovery support group meetings," said Edgren.

Bradley's father, Gary Cameron, mentioned that this graduation is a major moment for Cam-

eron and it will positively affect his life in the future.

"This is not just a graduation from drug court — this is a major life achievement," said Gary Cameron. "Since he has been in the program, he has reconnected with his family and had good relationships with his children."

Bradley Cameron said that, with the help of the employees within the drug court program, he was able to turn his life around and work towards his goals.

"In the span of eight months, I was feeling very

good about everything that I had accomplished," said Cameron. "I feel like I have a sense of purpose. I feel like I am going places."

Cameron mentioned that he will stay involved in the community, helping others, using the knowledge and experience that he has.

"Someday, maybe I will be a substance abuse counselor," said Cameron. "It is important to stay connected to the people within this community, because you can't do it on your own."

Cameron said that, as he continues to work, he hopes to find a place suitable for him and his children to live together.

According to Kussel, having a graduation of this magnitude can positively affect the life of the graduate as well as those around them.

"What it does, is that it recognizes that individual, coming out and changing their life," said Kussel. "It is a good lesson for others that are struggling — they think that if he did it, I can do it."

Kussel believes that this program is set up in a way to fully help those that need assistance with addiction.

"You can't solve drug problems just by interdiction, just by prosecution, just by treatment, just by education — you have to do everything," said Kussel.

While a part of the drug court program, participants have to complete many steps to reach graduation.

"The first thing that they have to do is stop using," said Kussel. "They are going to agree to be truthful with us and follow these steps. Some of these steps include not to use drugs, go to counseling, be responsible and take many drug tests."

Cameron said that he struggled along the way with the steps, but as graduation came closer, he was on the path to turning his life around.

"The biggest struggle in the beginning was living life on my terms, rather than those who could help me," said Cameron. "Eventually I saw that I could survive by doing things the right way, even though it was something that I was not used to."

Suit alleges attack in work release center

Former inmate seeks damages from county after assault by another inmate

A former Shawano County inmate severely beaten by another inmate in 2020 alleged in a recently filed lawsuit that the county failed to protect him in violation of his constitutional rights.

According to documents filed in federal court, Trevor Gueller, 20, was serving 90 days in custody with work release privileges as a condition of probation in September 2020, when Keith D. Wilber, 27, allegedly attacked him in the lunch area and continued to beat him after dragging Gueller into the shower area.

While the lawsuit stated the attack occurred in the jail, the county, in its response to the suit, said Gueller was in the Huber Work Release Center at the time of the attack.

Both areas are visible on a video surveillance system; however, no correctional officers allegedly responded to halt the attack.

Gueller suffered a concussion, a broken jaw, a fractured eye socket and broken teeth, along with other physical injuries.

The suit alleged that during the past three years there had been many attacks on inmates by other inmates and the video surveillance system was installed to monitor common areas.

The purpose of the video system is to reveal if an inmate attack is about to occur which would allow guards to intervene to prevent injury, according to the suit, and if the common areas aren't monitored, then a substantial risk that an inmate could be injured in an attack goes undetected.

In a phone interview April 13, Gueller's attorney, Paul Kinne, of

Madison, said his client's injuries were severe and went undiscovered for two days, which may be another claim added to the suit.

Kinne said he hasn't seen the video tape of the attack and that Gueller has "struggled to put a time frame," on how long it lasted.

The suit also alleged that either the guards failed to monitor the areas where Gueller was attacked knowing that it subjected inmates to injury or viewed the attack but failed to respond to it. In either scenario, the county is liable for Gueller's injuries and violated his constitutional protection against cruel and unusual punishment or guarantee of equal protection under law.

Kinne also said that the guards know that inmates can be a danger to one another and should be observed in person or on video.

"If they're not watching the surveillance system, what good does it do to have one?" he said.

The county acknowledged that no guards observed the lunch or shower areas while Gueller was being attacked. However, it denied liability for Gueller's injuries or that its policies violated his constitutional rights. It requested that the suit be dismissed.

Gueller was released from jail on Oct. 1, 2020. Wilber was transferred to Dodge Correctional Institution in Waupun and has a May 25 court date before Shawano-Menominee Circuit Court Judge Katherine Sloma on misappropriation of identity, resisting arrest and other charges.

The suit only names the county as a defendant. It seeks unspecified damages for Gueller's injuries, attorney fees and other costs.

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KPS uses \$15K grant to create educational games

CMN part of team to develop games

With assistance from the College of Menominee Nation, students and staff at Keshena Primary School have aided in developing a new way to teach material in the classroom.

The school received a \$15,000 grant from CMN to help develop nine games for Breakout EDU.

Breakout EDU is an educational website that provides 700 digital games and 600 games to be played in person with a Breakout EDU kit. The games consist of a scenario, where a group of people are given clues and that group must work together to solve the problem or the puzzle.

Amy Bohr, teacher and building technology coordinator at Keshena Primary, and other teachers have incorporated Breakout EDU into their lesson plans, differing from a traditional classroom setting of lectures.

"The games give the students a chance to learn multiple disciplines and subjects, like social studies, math, science and culture," said Bohr.

For in-person games, teachers are given virtual instructions to set up the puzzle within the classroom. This was made possible at KPS as money from the CMN library grant went into providing teachers with supplies for the games.

According to Laura Robinson, youth services librarian, the grant money was used to cover expenses of the supplies that went into the development of the games.

Amy Bohr was a part of the team that helped to develop nine games for Breakout EDU.

"We were given resources to both create the games and run the games," said Bohr. "Things like kits, posters and clues were given to us."

Students in the STEM program at KPS were also given the opportunity to travel down to Escape Green Bay and learn about the factors that going into creating and running games like those seen on Breakout EDU.

With the nine games that were developed by the students and staff at

the school, three of them have been published.

"We incorporated Menominee culture into the games that are published so far," said Bohr.

Due to the fact that Breakout EDU is open to the creation of games from all over the world, this allows students and teachers an opportunity to experience culture and different learning strategies from different parts of the planet.

"We call these games community created, in that different communities all around the world create games with that specific culture in mind," said Robinson.

According to Bohr, the COVID-19 pandemic affected the students' ability to create the games. When school

was shut down, members of the staff partook in weekly Zoom meetings and ultimately continued with the creation of the games.

This affected the students and staff ability to work together as Bohr mentioned that the students really enjoyed participating in the creation of the games.

KPS has adopted this style of teaching and learning as these games force students to work together in order to achieve their goal.

"With these games, students are actively learning," said Bohr. "They are collaboratively working together to reach their goal. Sometimes the students won't solve the puzzle, but they will be able to go back and used what they learned to try again."

Robinson said that working closely with the school on this project has opened up a collaboration between the library and the school.

"The College of Menominee Nation are doing activities for Earth Day," said Robinson. "CMN is providing these activities to the Keshena Primary School."

Robinson owes this opportunity to continue to work with the school to the trust that was built with the grant and the collaboration on the Breakout EDU project.

"This was a great opportunity for us to collaborate with the school," said Robinson. "This give us the chance to work closer with the school."

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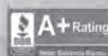
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County resolution honors missing, murdered natives

May 5 day of awareness for plight of indigenous women, girls

The Shawano County Board of Supervisors has designated May 5 a day of awareness for missing and murdered indigenous women.

The resolution, which received unanimous approval from the board, noted that a 2016 report from the National Institute of Justice stated that 84% of Native American women have experienced violence in their lifetime, and over half of those were prey to sexual violence. The resolution also noted a 2016 National Crime Information Center report that indicated 6,000 cases of missing and murdered Native women and girls, but the U.S. Department of Justice was only tracking about 100 cases.

The resolution noted the murders of Menominee tribal members Rae Tourtillot in 1986, Ingrid Washniwatok in 1999 and most recently, Katelyn Kelley in 2020, along with Lisa Ninham, who has been missing for 40 years. The resolution also noted murdered Ho-Chunk members Jennifer Wesho in 1989, Jacinda Muir in 2015 and Kozee Decorah in 2020.

The resolution would normally get its blessing from the county's tribal affairs committee, but the re-

quest for the observance came too late to make it on the committee's April meeting agenda, so it went through the executive committee instead for a recommendation, according to County Board Chairman Tom Kautza.

"The ladies who were requesting this wanted this done this month because it would never get through the process by the date they have in there to be honored," said Kautza, who noted that he spoke with Supervisor Kathy Luebke, who sits on both committees, and got her OK to have the executive committee sponsor the resolution. "This way, it gets done, and it's a good thing. It's just showing we do support that for them (the tribes)."

Supervisor Joe Miller, who also sits on the Stockbridge-Munsee Tribal Council, applauded the recognition by the county.

Supervisor Arlyn Tober questioned why the board was only recognizing missing and murdered women for one group.

"Why wouldn't it be for all women and girls?" Tober said.

Kautza pointed out that the request came from multiple tribes in the state, not just from the nearby Menominee, Ho-Chunk and Stockbridge-Munsee tribes.

"They just want a show of support and get a little more attention to be brought to this instead of just, when it happens, it goes away into the background," Kautza said.

In her free time, Dr. Young enjoys spending time with her friends and family, golfing, cheering on Wisconsin sports teams, kayaking on the Wolf River, and traveling. Dr. Young is thrilled to return to the area to provide exceptional patient care.

The survey takes about five minutes to complete, and individual responses will be kept confidential. Results will be available late this summer.



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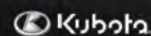
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Mondus plans to sell Anello's Torch Lite

Retiring owner

An iconic Shawano restaurant is up for sale.

Rita Mondus, the owner of Anello's Torch Lite, made the decision to sell on the heels of her pending retirement.

"I think it is about time for me to retire," said Mondus.

The eatery at 1276 E. Green Bay St. has been a popular dinner and drinks destination for more than a century. According to the Anello's website, torchliteshawano.com, the building, then known as The Continental, was a popular place in the "Roaring Twenties," often frequented by notorious gangsters, Al Capone and John Dillinger. In the 1920s, the upstairs of the building was known as "a house of ill repute." The restaurant then became known as Club Continental until 1969, when it was changed to the Bavarian Inn.

The name changed one more time to Anello's Torch Lite in 1981, when Mondus took over. She has been working at the restaurant for 44 years.

The restaurant is known for its soups, salads and fresh baked breads, as well as Friday fish fries.

Mondus talked about the great memories that she has shared with the many customers who have come into the restaurant during her career.

"The people in general made it special; I love the people," she said. "It is a great business, it is never dull and always extremely interesting. You never know from minute to minute what is going to happen in this business."

Mondus, who has lived in Shawano her whole life, praised how the community has been in supporting her and the business.

"A lot of people are saying that they do not want it to change," said Mondus. "There has also been positive support with people understanding and congratulating me on retirement."

Mondus believes that Anello's Torch Lite plays a big role within the Shawano community.

"If you look at it, it is a very lovely, elite contribution to the community," said Mondus. "It is a nice gathering place. People know the name Torch Lite, with the old building being built in 1897."

Mondus also explained that many people have a personal connection with this building.

"People remember their weddings, their birthdays, their anniversaries and even the baptisms of their babies here," said Mondus. "It has a lot of familiar thought. Even though it is a new building, people still know the area."

While its petting zoo is a special attraction, Mondus credits the success of the business to the good, basic food and a friendly atmosphere.

"People love to gather," said Mondus. "We happen to be a nice central place for people traveling from Wausau and Green Bay. We are also up north from Chicago and Milwaukee, but we are not too far up north."

The area's casinos in the area have been a big contribution to the business as well, she said.

"People always draw up to the casinos and always want a good place to eat," Mondus said. "Hopefully we give them good food and a great atmosphere."

Mondus looked back at her time within the Shawano community and at Anello's Torch Lite in a positive light.

"It is home," said Mondus. "What else can you say, it is home, it warms my heart; these are my people."

The current Anello's Torch Lite building is fairly new because the restaurant burned down on Dec. 30,

2014. The building that stands today was constructed in 2015 and reopened in 2016. After the building was rebuilt, she thought about selling for a while.

"We built it to pretty much think of selling it," Mondus said. "But it just becomes part of you. You think you have got forever until you look in the mirror and say it is time to wake up if you want to do something else."

A couple of people have looked at buying the building, but nothing yet leading to an actual sale, she said.

After she retires, Mondus said she plans to stay in the community and spend more time playing with her animals and meeting up with friends.

"After I retire, I just plan on hanging out in the community and sitting on the other side of the bar," Mondus said.

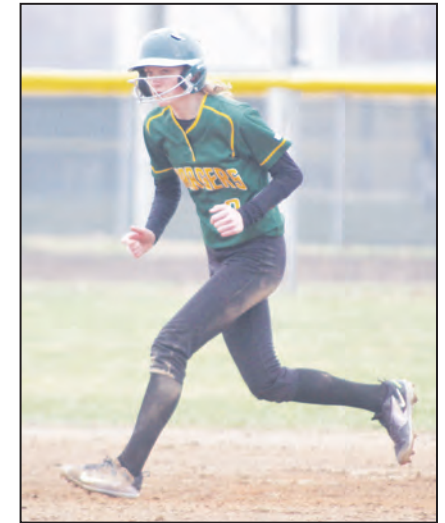

Pineapple Port is a Florida retirement community. Residents are at least 55 with one exception – thirty-something Charlotte Morton.

The orphaned Charlotte was raised there by her grandmother. By the time her grandmother died, Charlotte was in her late teens and a part of the community, so rules were bent allowing her to stay.

Growing up with a county sheriff nearby gave Charlotte a taste for detecting, and she has been shadowing Sheriff Frank. A man has been found face down in a bowl of cereal. His wife died only two days ago. When Charlotte discovers a very sick sphinx (hairless) cat, she and Frank suspect poisoning.

USDA offers resources for maple producers

The U.S. Department of Agriculture offers technical expertise and financial assistance to help Wisconsin maple producers fund their operations, conserve natural resources and recover from natural disasters.

The state's Farm Service Agency offers funding opportunities to help maple producers start, expand and maintain their operations.

FSA's Farm Storage Facility Loan Program provides low-interest financing so producers can build or upgrade facilities to store certain commodities. Maple sap and maple syrup are both eligible, and equipment and facilities such as sap tanks, certain hauling trucks and storage space for maple syrup qualify. Eligible facilities and equipment may be new or used, permanently affixed or portable.

Additionally, there are several types of farm loans available to help maple producers finance their businesses. These loans are administered through FSA and offer access to

funding for a wide range of agricultural needs, from securing land and constructing buildings to financing the purchase of equipment.

Maple producers are encouraged to visit farmers.gov/fund to learn more about USDA funding opportunities.

Natural Resources Conservation Service offers programs and services that benefit Wisconsin maple producers while conserving natural resources. Maple producers are encouraged to visit farmers.gov/conserve to learn more about conservation at USDA and working with your local conservationists.

Producers in Wisconsin may also qualify for NRCS programs that support conservation efforts across maple operations. The Environmental Quality Incentives Program (EQIP) provides financial assistance and technical support to help maple producers address natural resource concerns through voluntary conservation practices. Multiple conservation practices

for qualifying maple producers may be available through EQIP, including those to increase energy efficiency, improve evaporation rates, and benefit forest health.

NRCS's Conservation Stewardship Program is available for eligible maple producers to maintain and improve existing conservation systems and adopt additional conservation practices to address resource concerns. Activities might include those to help strengthen an existing sugar bush or with a different focus such as wildlife habitat or water quality.

FSA and USDA's Risk Management Agency (RMA) offer programs to help maple producers prepare for and recover from the impacts of natural disasters.

Federal crop insurance is administered through RMA to provide a robust and reliable farm safety net, regardless of the size and scope of natural disasters. RMA's Whole-Farm Revenue Protection covers all com-

modities on the farm, including maple, under one insurance policy.

FSA's Noninsured Crop Disaster Assistance Program helps producers manage risk through coverage for both crop losses and crop planting that was prevented due to natural disasters. The eligible or "noninsured" crops cover agricultural commodities not covered by federal crop insurance, including specialty crops such as maple sap.

Through the Tree Assistance Program, FSA offers financial assistance to eligible orchardists and nursery tree growers to replant or rehabilitate eligible trees, bushes and vines lost due to natural disasters. This includes eligible maple trees from which an annual crop is produced for commercial purposes.

Maple producers are encouraged to visit farmers.gov/recover to learn more about USDA resources to manage risk and recover from natural disasters.

ThedaCare first to install blood analyzer technology

System expected to reduce risk of error, produce results in minutes

Care teams at ThedaCare have secured new technology expected to enhance comprehensive and coordinated care for patients.

According to Grifols, a company that develops plasma-derived therapies and is a leader in development of innovative diagnostic solutions, ThedaCare Medical Center-Wild Rose is the first hospital in North America to install the DG Reader Net semi-automated analyzer, used to facilitate pre-transfusion blood type compatibility testing. This analyzer offers laboratories computer-assisted reading and interpretation of immunohematology (IH) tests with automatic results that are

uploaded to the Laboratory Information System.

"When our lab teams draw blood from a patient, we run a series of tests on that blood," said Rebecca Schultz, blood bank key operator at ThedaCare Medical Center-Wild Rose. "We screen for antibodies, antigens, as well as determine the blood type. The DG Reader Net semi-automated analyzer reads those results and exports everything to one centralized system."

Before the analyzer, team members would need to read results and then manually enter them into the system.

"By using the analyzer, we believe

it has ability to minimize the potential for error, and create additional time for our team members to provide care for our patients," said Elizabeth Kujawa, laboratory manager at ThedaCare Medical Center-Wild Rose. "There are no room for mistakes when it comes to blood types and having accurate information in the event of a blood transfusion."

The reader can have results in minutes, according to Schultz. The amount of time saved can help during those immediate responses where blood transfusions might be needed in critical access hospitals like Wild Rose.

For the smallest and most specialized laboratories, DG Reader Net is designed to work as both a standalone solution or integrate with Grifols' fully automated DG Gel system for a truly scalable solution. At ThedaCare, Information Services developed and implemented the software to allow hospitals to share the information.

"It's very neat to use the program," said Schultz. "If I have results in Wild Rose, a provider in Neenah can take a look at those results in real time and, if needed, provide recommendations for care. It's another tool that allows us to provide comprehensive care across our system."
